WHAT ARE POP UPS? WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU CLICK ON THEM?

Faux Paw learns that downloading is a great way to get information . . . if it's done the right way. But she also learns the hard way that illegal downloading hurts everyone, including herself!

TIP: Ask for help from an adult as you work on this worksheet!

Words to Know:

- Common Sense the sense that someone or something isn't safe. For example, if something isn't free
 in a store, it shouldn't be free online.
- Internet Stranger someone who you meet on the Internet but you do not know in real life.
- Popups a screen that "pops up" on your computer when on the Internet that asks you to click on it. Clicking can take you away from the place you were and to another place that is not safe.
- Trusted adult a person who is very close to you who knows what websites are safe, like a parent or teacher.


Think About:
