WHAT ARE PEER-TO-PEER FILE SHARING SITES?

Faux Paw learns about peer-to-peer file sharing and downloading using the internet.

TIP: Ask for help from an adult as you work on this worksheet!

Words to Know:

- Peer-to-peer - P2P means person-to-person, like one person to another person or one computer to another computer. It's where your computer peeks onto someone else's computer to copy something from it, like a game or a song. It could be bad stuff like a virus that hurts your computer.
- Download - to get something from the Internet and save it to your computer's storage, like a picture, a song or a game.
- Personal files - Files on your computer that belong only to you, like your photos, music and games. These should not be shared with anyone without permission from a trusted adult like a parent or teacher.

Do this:

- Draw a picture, write a story, or make something you are proud of.

Think About:

- Think how it would feel if someone took the thing you made without your permission.
- How would it feel if you wanted to sell it for money, but someone gave it away without asking you first?
