WHAT ARE THE THREE KEEPS OF INTERNET SAFETY

There are 3 things to remember online. These are called “The Three Keeps”:

- I keep safe.....my personal information.
- I keep away.....from internet strangers.
- I keep telling.....my trusted adult about everything I see on the internet.

💡 TIP: Ask for help from an adult as you work on this worksheet!

Think About:

What are your favorite places to go on the internet?

Do those places feel safe?

Have you ever had someone ask you tricky questions? If so, talk to your trusted adult about it.

Ask a grown up to help you:

- Print the next page.
- Color it .
- Hang it up where you can see it and remember it.

Howdy kids! I'm your friend, Cursor. Remember, the internet is a like a big city with great places to go, but you have to be careful. That's why we have three rules for internet safety:



KEEP SAFE - KEEP AWAY - KEEP TELLING



- ☆ I **KEEP SAFE** my personal information - all of it.
I never give my real name, address, phone number, the name of my school, or a picture of myself to anyone online.
- ☆ I **KEEP AWAY** from internet strangers -
no matter what they tell me, because I have no way of knowing who they really are. I don't talk with them online, and I never meet them face-to-face.
- ☆ I **KEEP TELLING** my parents or a trusted adult about everything I see on the internet -
I always tell them when something makes me uncomfortable.
